



Open Access Policies

- Open Access Publication Fund for gold open access publications (e.g. at ZHAW)
- Read and Publish Agreements with publishers (e.g. <u>at ZHAW</u>)
- Insititutional Repositories for Green Open Access (e.g. <u>ZHAW</u> <u>digitalcollection</u>)
- Staff, e.g. at Libraries and ICT Departements

Open access - the new normal

Do you receive funding for your research from the SNSF? If so, you are obliged to make the resulting publications available to third parties free of charge. Research results funded with public money belong to the public. Free digital access is good for science, the economy and society as a whole. And it will make your work more visible and more impactful. Apply to the SNSF for an open access publication grant now.

SNSF Funding Books



2.7 Manner and amount of funding

- ¹ For digital books, the SNSE awards grants according to the following rates:
- a. Maximum grant of CHF 12,000 for a basic digital book publication;
- b. Maximum grant of CHF 22,000 for an enriched digital book publication (enriched e-book);
- c. Lump sum of CHF 8,000 for doctoral theses or habilitations.
- ²The maximum amounts as stipulated under paragraphs 1 letters a and b may be increased if the digital book has to meet higher production requirements, particularly in the case of editions and expensive image rights.
- ³ The lump sum as stipulated under paragraph 1 letter c may be increased if a publisher's calculation is submitted to the SNSF in which the additional costs are sufficiently documented.

Participation requirements

 Monographs are comprehensive, peer-reviewed scientific works. The SNSF includes dissertations, habilitations, legal commentaries and editions in this category. The SNSF does not award grants for textbooks, special issues of journals, conference proceedings, new editions or translations.



Why OER needs funding, too

OER professionals ...



Teaching materials produced at higher education institutions that receive public funding should be published comprehensively as OER.

Teachers ...

But most teaching materials in Switzerland contain copyrighted materials of other authors – which might be used in classroom settings and closed LMS according to CopA 19(1)(b). They are not built to be published and there are no workflows for publication or quality control in place.



Open Educational Resources (OER) Policy

1. Preamble

Open educational resources (OER) are seen as having great potential in the area of university teaching, for example in supporting methodological-didactic approaches, as well as in updating and further developing standardised and rapidly changing educational content and even in supporting individual teaching-learning processes.

OER also have potential in the area of education policy, as they have a positive impact on educational participation and the permeability of the education system. OER, thus, support the <u>fourth UN Sustainable Development Goal</u> by ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education and promoting lifelong learning opportunities.





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Pillars of the OER Repository

- Realisation with edu-sharing (like <u>ZOERR</u>, <u>twillo</u>)
- Content from HEI (material for tertiary education only)
- Quality assurance: login with SWITCH edu-ID, upload by partners only
- Free search and download: No login required
- 5. Moodle plugin



OER-Repository for Swiss HEI: State



SWITCH is discussing to set up a pilot project and offer participation as a service.

Costs (compared to Open Access)

- not concrete yet, but might be in the area of what SNSF grants for one enriched digital book
- will not go into the hands of commercial publishers but into the development of open source software for OER publishing (sustainable)
- no ICT staff and hosting in the institution required.

UNESCO recommendation on OER

- <u>Swiss National Open Science Strategy</u>: 4.2 Weaknesses ... «The low level of activity in application domains like Citizen Science, Open Innovation or Open Education in Swiss HEI ...» / «Open education requires appropriate resources, tools and practices to meet initial discourses and ultimately the demands of quality.» (p. 10)
